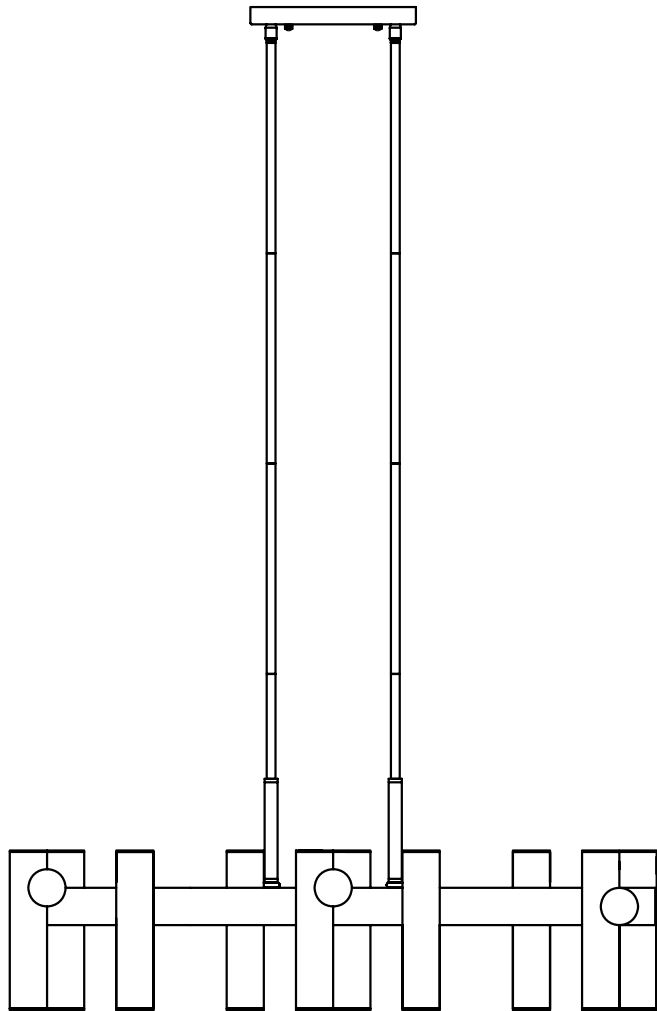

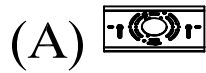
This fixture is designed to dim with an Electronic Low Voltage dimmer. Dimming levels will vary by dimmer. Below is a List of Recommended Dimmers:

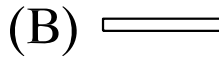
Due to inrush current wattage should not exceed 150 watts of product for a 600 watt dimmer.

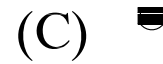

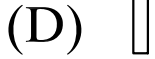
(A) Mounting Bracket



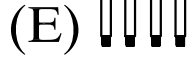
(B) Canopy

(D) Tubes(2PCS)

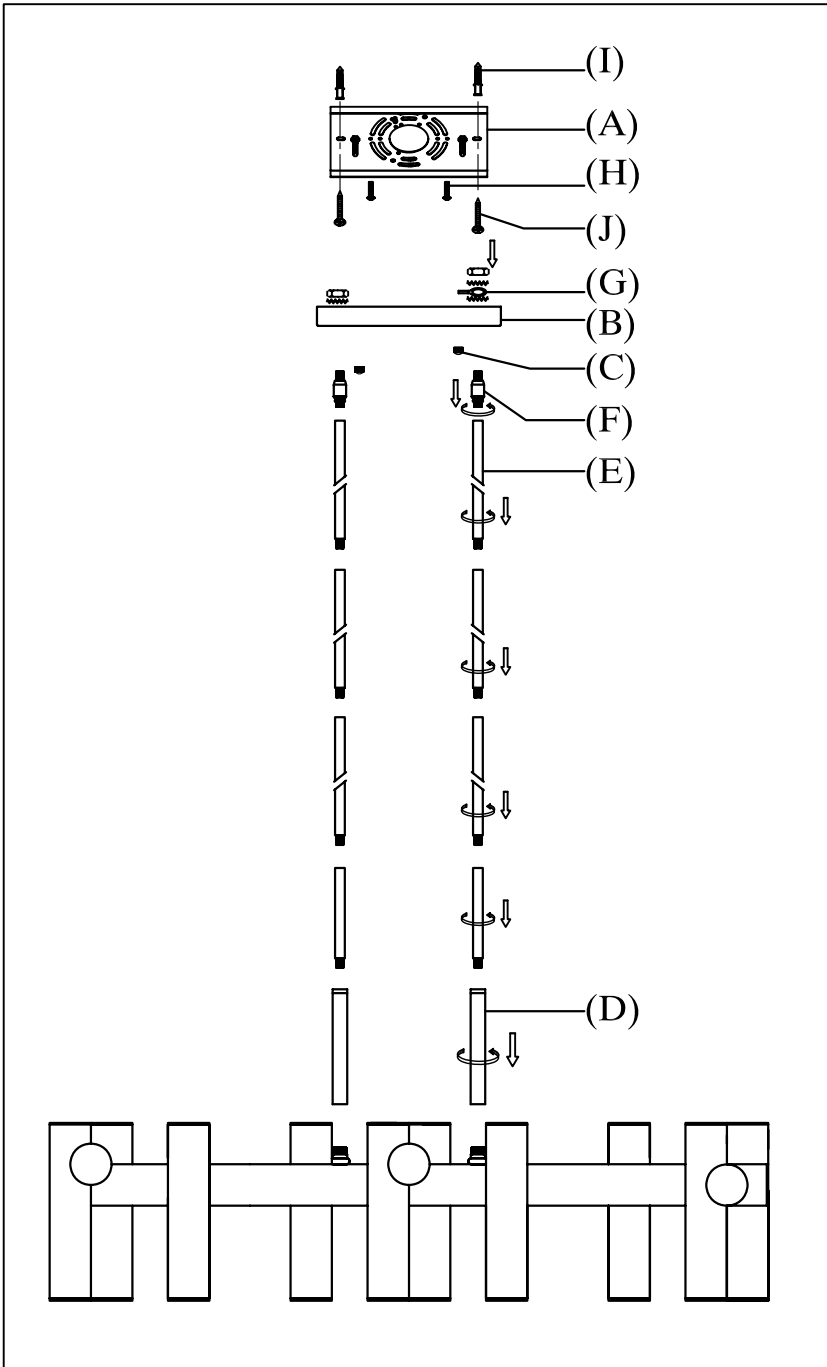

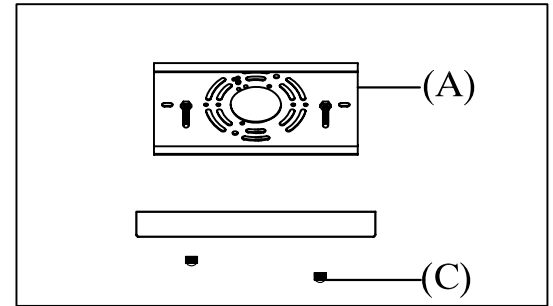

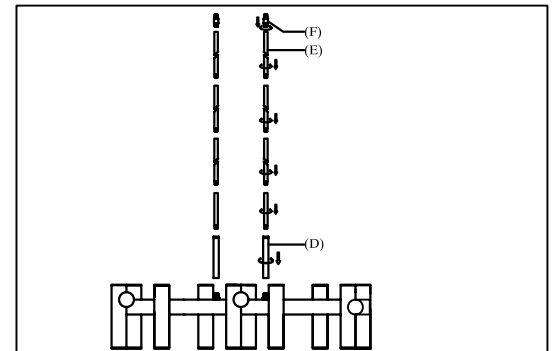

step1:Remove mounting bracket from canopy.


step2:Run wire through stems and combine stem lengths to meet desired mounting height.

Cleaning & Care:


Clean with soft cloth and a mild detergent.

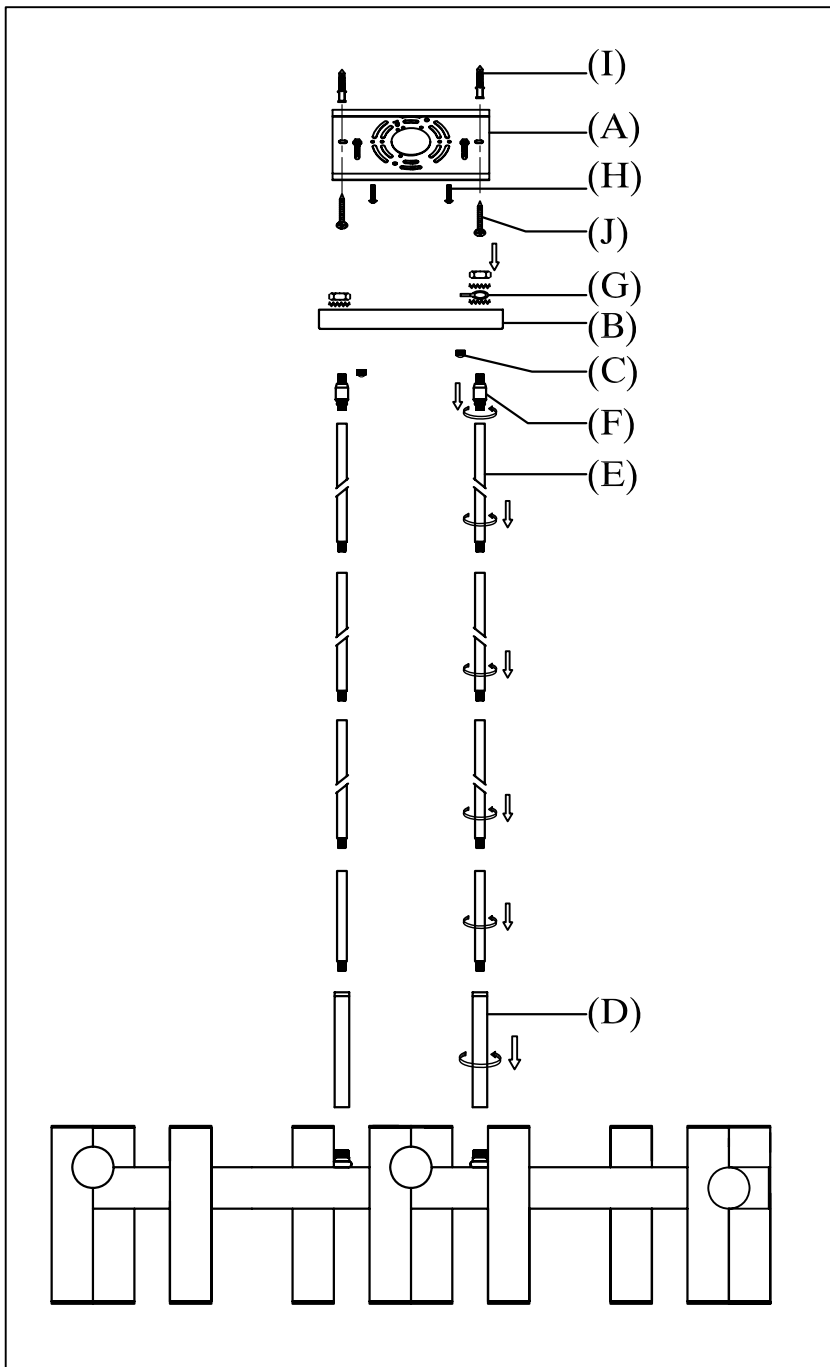

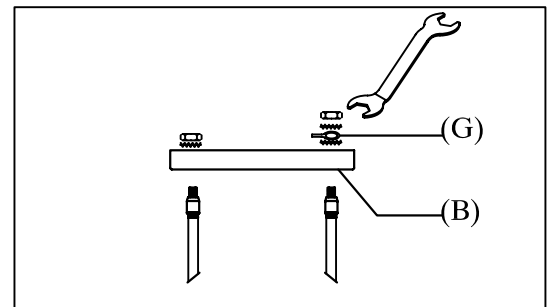

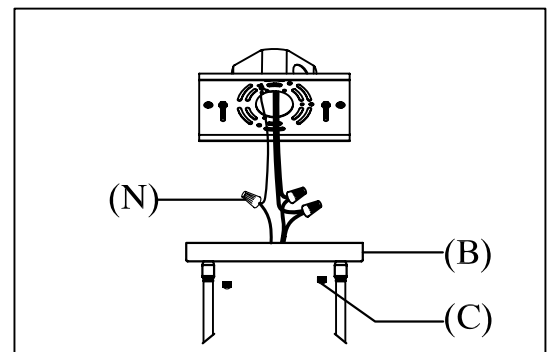

step3:Secure the rod assembly to the set nipple of the canopy as shown in diagram.

step4:Mark where screws at ends of bracket meet the ceiling. Remove mounting bracket from ceiling. Drill holes using $3/16'' \pm$ drill bit where marked. Install mounting bracket to outlet box and attach anchors to secure bracket at ends. Wire fixture to wires in outlet box. Green wire is for Ground. Install fixture to bracket and tighten ball nuts at the ends of the canopy to secure.

Cleaning & Care:

Clean with soft cloth and a mild detergent.
Do not use abrasive cleaner.
